Auberge Beach Residences & Spa Fort Lauderdale, the first ultra-luxury mixed-use development in the sun-filled destination, is attracting the likes of Miami Dolphin's legend Dan Marino and philanthropist and lifestyle/entertaining author Annie Falk.

The 171-unit Auberge Beach Residences and Spa Fort Lauderdale, which is being developed by the two powerhouses that many say put Miami on the luxury real estate map: The Related Group and Fortune International Group, is housed in two iconic towers with sweeping ocean views and expansive terraces for year-round indoor-outdoor living.

Auberge Resorts Collection, is overseeing every aspect of the lifestyle, including the restaurants and Auberge Spa. Related Group's Jorge Pérez, a renowned art collector and patron Miami's Perez Art Museum (PAMM), has committed to installing a museum-quality art collection, which will be anchored by La Maternidad, a monumental bronze sculpture by celebrated contemporary master Fernando Botero. Internationally acclaimed design team includes interior design firm Meyer Davis Studios and architecture firm Nichols, Brosch, Wurst, Wolf & Associates.

Residence features include: expansive terraces, some with private pools; flow-through contemporary floor plans with 9'6" floor-to-ceiling windows; private elevator access and entry foyers in all residences; gourmet kitchens with Sub-Zero and Wolf appliances.

Pricing for two- through five-bedroom residences ranges from \$1.5 to \$8 million.
